CD-4-SW, 400 H. P. - 4-wheel truck switcher

In the past our Diesel locomotives have been classed as 1050, 1070, 1010, 1300, 1200 and 1100 Class, but as we have made our 1050 and 1070 Class the same - 4 wheel truck - a new system of classification should be set up; therefore, if this meets with your approval will you please advise.
