In accordance with your telephone request of last week, I radiced The Alaska Railroad as to the condition of the steam locomotives which are now surplus to the railroad's operation and which are up for sale on a competitive bid basis. I am attaching a carbon copy of the railroad's reply.

You will notice that the railroad has in steam locomotives (lima) and 10 steam locomotives (haldwin) for a total of 2h, all in operating condition. Please note also that where repairs are required, the cost of such repairs will not exceed \$2,000 per locomotive.

He greatly appreciate your interest and assistance in the matter of disposing of these surplus locomotives.
