LOCOMOTIVES

Diesel road units in service to date have been changed from 17 to 15, thus changing the total number of locomotives in service to date from 67 to 65.

Total requirements for Diesel road units have been changed from 24 to 22, thus changing the total requirements of locomotives from 74 to 72.

PASSENGER EQUIPMENT

Two cars have been leased to the Department of Health, Territory of Alaska. They are one hospital car and one dormitory car and are indicated on the report by an asterisk. The hospital car is the hospital car #1. The dormitory car was formerly the Arctic, buffet coach #7. These cars are still numbered 1 and 7 respectively and the number 7 is at present undergoing remodeling to convert it from a buffet coach to a dormitory car. On previous reports, the buffet coach #7 (Arctic) has been included with the buffet coaches. It is now shown separately on the report as a dormitory car and necessary figure changes have been made.

Power cars have been added and totals adjusted accordingly.
